General terms and conditions of subscription

Version 2023

(The French version prevails)

Object

The purpose of these General Terms and Conditions of Subscription (GTC) is to define the conditions under which the Community Watch Service held by CENTREDOC is made available to the Customer.

Duration of subscription

The subscription is concluded for a period of one year. The start date of the subscription is specified in the Order Form. After expiry of its term, the subscription is tacitly renewed for one calendar year unless denounced in writing, at the latest, 3 months before the expiry of the latter.

Remuneration

In return for the services subject of the subscription, the Customer undertakes to pay CENTREDOC the price indicated on the Order Form. A price increase is possible with each subscription renewal. CENTREDOC must communicate the new price in writing two (2) months before the tacit renewal date, including the reasons for this increase.

Billing, Payment

Subscriptions are invoiced to the Customer by CENTREDOC in accordance with the pricing shown on the Order Form signed by the Customer, or according to the new price communicated two (2) months before the tacit renewal date of the subscriptions. The customer undertakes to pay each invoice issued by CENTREDOC upon receipt thereof. An invoice not paid within thirty (30) days of its establishment is deemed late and the sums due will bear interest automatically from this date on the basis of one and a half times the legal interest rate. Any recovery costs incurred by the Customer's late payments, including legal costs, remain his responsibility. In the event of late payment or non-compliance by the Client with any of its obligations under these GTC, CENTREDOC may suspend or cancel subscriptions until full payment of the invoice or performance of its obligations by the Client.

Service

Access to Community Vigeries is provided by CENTREDOC and is included in the price invoiced to the Customer. It is carried out via the Internet, is secured by encryption and by the use of a User Code. Some subscriptions also entitle you to a hard copy of all or a selection of the data covered by the community watches to which the customer has subscribed.

Obligations of the Client

The Customer must scrupulously respect these General Terms and Conditions of Subscription (GTC) to the Community Watches. No changes can be made. It is the Customer's responsibility to provide his own terminal, router or any other equipment or software necessary to access the Community Watch in their electronic version, to ensure that his equipment is compatible with the technical standards of Internet access, to his Internet service provider and to the platform made available by CENTREDOC. The Customer acknowledges that he is solely responsible for his access to the Internet.

User Access

After validation of the subscription by CENTREDOC, CENTREDOC gives the Customer a series of user accesses allowing access to the designated employees to the service for which the Customer has concluded a subscription.

If subsequently requested in writing by the Customer, additional user access may be granted to the Customer, provided that the Customer meets the terms and conditions set forth in these GTC.

Restriction on the type of users: User Access is for the exclusive use of users employed by the Customer. Their use by any third party outside the company, including subsidiaries, parent company or related companies, is prohibited, except with the written authorization of CENTREDOC.

Copyright

The subscriptions and these GTC do not confer any intellectual property rights on the Client, either on the software or on the content of the Community Watches.

Changes to the Service

CENTREDOC reserves the right to change or modify the characteristics of the Community Watch with 1 month's notice, in order to improve the Service or add new features. The Customer acknowledges accepting these changes, from which he may benefit.

Removal of the Service

CENTREDOC deletes the Service in the following cases:

- when the Client makes use of the Service contrary to the GTC;
- when the amounts due for subscriptions are not paid within the agreed deadlines;
- when CENTREDOC deletes the Service, which it must announce in writing to the customer at least three (3) months in advance.

In cases a and b, sums already paid are not returned; where, in case c, the cancellation occurs in the first half of the accounting period, CENTREDOC shall refund half of the amount paid for the year in question.

Guarantees - Liability

The guarantee enjoyed by the Customer consists in the continuity, availability and security of the Service.

CENTREDOC may interrupt the Service from time to time and without notice for maintenance purposes. CENTREDOC guarantees that the interruption of the Service for maintenance reasons will not exceed forty-eight working hours.

Any effect that the Internet service provider used by the Customer will induce on the Service, and in particular its availability or response time, is not the responsibility of CENTREDOC. CENTREDOC will in no way be held responsible for the use of the Service by unauthorized users.

The liability of CENTREDOC is limited in all cases to the amount of the last annual subscription.

Non-transmission and non-assignment

All or part of the rights subject to the subscription may not be transferred in any way, sublicensed, assigned or transmitted by the Customer in any way whatsoever, and any attempt at assignment or transmission will be null and void.

Entirety

These General Terms and Conditions of Subscription replace the previous versions.

Disability

If any of the provisions of these GTC are declared invalid or unenforceable by a competent court or administrative body, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the remaining provisions of the GTC, which shall remain fully applicable and valid. The parties will then negotiate and agree on a provision that comes as close as possible to the intentions of these GTC.

Place of jurisdiction and applicable law

In the event of a dispute, the place of jurisdiction is exclusively at the registered office of CENTREDOC (currently in Neuchâtel). Swiss law, excluding conflict of law rules, shall apply.
